Terms and Conditions – 2022 International Scholarships

Scholarship Conditions – a student applying for a scholarship accepts the following conditions:

1. Students applying for the scholarship must complete the online application form on the international pages of the school website
2. Students must **not** have accepted an offer to another Australian school at the time of application
3. The number of scholarships offered in one year is at the discretion of the Headmaster. In some years it may be that no scholarship is offered
4. Scholarships are a maximum of 20% of the advertised international student tuition fee. The discount is applied to each fee invoice
5. The student accepts that the decision of the Headmaster is final, and no negotiation will be entered into
6. In the event that a student changes their visa type during enrolment, the applied tuition discount will be 20% of the domestic tuition fee on a pro-rata basis.
7. It is a condition to sit **both** the iDat and AEAS test as part of their application process. (The School should be contacted if these tests are not available in their home country)
8. Applicants will be required to attend an interview either online or in person
9. It is expected that a student on a scholarship will remain enrolled and graduate at Macarthur at the end of Year 12
10. Scholarship students are expected to maintain a GPA of 8.6 or above during their enrolment. Significant falls in the GPA of a student may result in the scholarship being withdrawn
11. Scholarship students are expected to participate in Socrates each year
12. Students are expected to demonstrate strong leadership especially within international students
13. Students are expected to display an exemplary discipline record. Serious breaches of the school's discipline policy or poor homestay behaviour may result in a scholarship being withdrawn
14. As with all students, scholarship students are expected to attend school camps and Speech Night annually (it is encouraged but not expected that students will attend Speech Night at the end of Year 12)
15. Students on scholarship in Year 11 are expected to attend the Year 11 Macarthur Ball and the Year 12 Graduation Dinner
16. A student can only apply for a scholarship a maximum of two times – once on entry and once in Year 11 however only one scholarship will be granted to a student during their enrolment
17. All students on scholarships must maintain the conditions of their Student Visa 500. Breaching any of the visa requirements may result in the scholarship being withdrawn
