The teaching and learning the Indonesian Language is compulsory at Macarthur from Transition (Pre-Kindergarten) to Year 8, with elective Indonesian and HSC, including Extension Indonesian. The Headmaster seeks to appoint an appropriately qualified and experienced Christian educator to this permanent position. The successful candidate will join the highly professional, dynamic, industrious Foreign Languages Faculty. A willingness to teach across Transition (Pre-K) to Stage 4 will be a distinct advantage.

Candidates will be required to demonstrate:

- a comprehensive understanding of classroom differentiation;
- a commitment to detailed and timely feedback to students; and,
- a deep understanding of how students think and learn.

The successful candidate will also need to demonstrate innovative use of ICT in teaching and learning, proficiency in writing teaching programmes, and an understanding of best practices in student assessment and feedback. The desire to contribute to the outdoor education and co-curricular programmes that provide a rich experience for our students and a rewarding sense of job satisfaction for our teachers is imperative.
