The successful candidate must be able to tutor in small workshop-style groups and conduct a large ensemble when required.

The successful candidate must have performance and music tertiary qualifications. They also need to be available every Tuesday during term-time from 10.30am to 2.40pm, as well as a willingness to take on private Violin and/or Viola students outside of the programme hours (time and fee at their discretion).

Candidates for this role will also be required to demonstrate:

- a passion for teaching and a deep knowledge of string pedagogy and curriculum designs;
- an innovative approach to teaching Violin students;
- a commitment to detailed and timely feedback to students; and,
- an ability to work within a teaching team.
